

Dear DU Students and Colleagues,

The 2018 URSCI Expo and Global Learning Symposium will be held on **April 4, 2018**. The URSCI Expo is open to undergraduate and post-baccalaureate students. The Global Learning Symposium is open to undergraduate, post-baccalaureate, and graduate students. **Applications for poster, panel or oral presentations are accepted now through Friday, February 23.** In this message I'll provide some more details about the application process. 1. All applications must be completed by students. During the application process, students must identify a faculty sponsor. The application site can be accessed through the link https://jicsweb1.dom.edu/ICS/Students/URSCI_Expo_Global_Learning_Symposium.jnz or https://jicsweb1.dom.edu/ICS/Resources/URSCI_GLS_Application/URSCI_GLS_Online_Application.jnz.
 - If a team or group of students wishes to apply for participation in the event, the team should designate a leader who applies on behalf of the team. The team members (co-presenters) can then be listed as part of the application.
 - If a student is making more than one individual presentation, they must share a Word document draft of any additional application with the faculty sponsor. That faculty sponsor can work with URSCI Director, Professor Marion Weedermann or Executive Director of the Academic Enrichment Center Paul Simpson to submit that application.
 - If a student who recently graduated is looking to make a presentation, the student should contact either URSCI Director, Prof. Marion Weedermann or Executive Director of the AEC, Paul Simpson.
2. Once an application has been submitted by a student, the specified faculty sponsor will be notified and be asked to review the application. The faculty sponsor must approve the application before it will be considered by the URSCI Expo & GLS review committee.
3. Completed applications will be reviewed by the URSCI Expo & GLS review committee and notify the applicants by March 1st.

We are hoping for an energetic and fun-filled event but it can't happen without you.
